### **Važne informacije**

Plivači 11 god. ne mogu da plivaju trke duže od 1.000 m.

Plivači 12 i 13 god. ne mogu da plivaju trke duže od 2.500 m.

Plivači sa navršenih 14 i 15 godina mogu da plivaju Maraton (10 km) isključivo uz odobrenje organizatora (kada se radi o reprezentativcima).

Trka na 5 km vremenski je ograničena na maksimalno 120 minuta.

Trke na 7.5 i 10 km su vremenski ograničene za muškarce na maksimalno 125 minuta, a za žene na 135 minuta (uslov da se održe je minimum 5 prijavljenih učesnika na svakoj od njih).

Licenciranim takmičarima SSPOV rezultati će biti objavljeni u bazi PSS i međunarodnim bazama i zvanično priznati.

**Para-plivači** koji imaju takmičarske legitimacije SSPOV dobrodošli su da učestvuju bez ograničenja na svim trkama osim maratona i oslobođeni su plaćanja kotizacije učešća.

Obaranje vremenskog rekorda na stazi 5 km nagrađuje se novčanom nagradom. Pobjednički tim u Štafeti nagrađuje se medaljama.

Pobednici se nagrađuju medaljama u uzrasnim kategorijama i peharima u apsolutnoj konkurenciji.

## Staza plivanja

Cilj je na istom mestu gde i start. Plivanje se odvija na kružnoj stazi u smeru suprotnom od kazaljke na satu. Markirana je velikim bovama (dve narandžaste 80x120cm, 90x160cm i dve žute 150x160cm, 90x160cm). Između velikih bova se nalaze male bove narandžaste boje sa plavim zastavicama. Ulazak u ciljnu zonu obeležen je narandžastim stazama (50m) i crvenim zastavicama, a ciljna kapija obeležena je vertikalnim markerima. Na okretima se nalaze sudije koji registruju pravilne prolaskе plivača. Takmičari su dužni da bove obilaze sa desne strane, odnosno da pored njih prolaze svojim levim ramenom. Prosečna dubina vode na stazi plivanja je 2-6 m.

**Konačni rezultati** biće istaknuti na oglasnoj tabli u 17:15 časova, prigovor se može podneti u roku od narednih 10 min. kod vrhovnog sudije. Spiker će putem razglosa obavestiti takmičare o početku roka za podnošenje, odnosno isteku roka.

**Kontrola praćenja** plivača odvija se preko bova na okretima gde će se nalaziti sudije koje će vršiti kontrolu preko brojeva na kapticama i stikera na telu plivača. Plivačima će biti mereno prolazno vreme na svakom krugu plivanja kod prolaska kroz kapiju cilja.

Takmičari dobijaju na korišćenje čip narukvicu koju su dužni da nakon dolaska na cilj vrate organizatoru. Gubitak čipa naplaćuje se 50 Eur u dinarskoj protivrednosti. U toku plivanja obavezno je nošenje brendirane kape dobijene od organizatora radi lakše identifikacije. U slučaju da plivači žele da koriste svoju kapu dužni su da je nose ispod službene kape i da o tome obaveste člana tima za registraciju.

## Takmičenje je podeljeno na tri dela:

**Prvi deo**, gde se vrši provera takmičara da li su pripremljeni za ulazak u vodu

- svaki plivač treba da bude propisno obeležen svojim brojem (noga, ruka, rame, lopatica, kapa)
- svaki plivač na ruci nosi svoju čip narukvicu
- plivači ne mogu da nose nikakav nakit, satove, piercing i sl.
- plivači najavljene distance moraju biti prisutni na mestu za prozivanje pred ulazak na startni ponton
- direktor trke će obavestiti oficira za bezbednost da je Prvi start spreman
- vrhovni sudija daje Drugi Start zvukom sirene. Start se izvodi sa pontona.

**Drugi deo** podrazumeva kontrolu takmičenja i praćenje broja plivača u vodi preko sledećih mehanizama:

- praćenje plivača od strane sudija na okretima bova
- praćenje plivača po međuvremenima koje pruža "Race Results" (plivači su dužni da tokom proplivavanja kroz ciljnu kapiju jednom rukom dodirnu ciljnu tablu kako bi senzori detektovali rezultat sa čip narukvice)

- oficir za bezbednost mora biti obavešten o svakom incidentu u vodi

**Treći deo** je kontrola na Cilju gde će plivačima biti zabeleženo službeno vreme preko "Race Results".

U slučaju evakuacije tim Spasilaštvo na vodi preduzeće sve potrebne mere neugrožavajući ostale plivače na stazi plivanja. Plivači će dobiti uputstva za ponašanje u vodi usled naglog pogoršanja vremenskih prilika kako bi uz asistenciju tima Spasilaštvo na vodi bezbedno napustili vodu. U slučaju da se primeti nestanak plivača na stazi plivanja potraga će započeti na prvoj kontrolnoj tački na kojoj nedostaju podaci o plivaču.

**O bezbednosti plivača** brine profesionalni spasilački tim (spasioci-ronioci) sa razrađenim Akcionim planom za Hitnu evakuaciju i pružanje Prve Pomoći. Tokom odvijanja trke uz stazu plivanja patroliraju kajaci i čamci, dok na obali dežura vozilo sa medicinskom službom Hitne Pomoći. Komunikacija između timova odvija se preko sistema radio veze voda-voda, voda-zemlja i zemlja-zemlja.

**Na startnom pontonu** mogu boraviti sudije, spasioci, merioci vremena, tim Prve Pomoći Crvenog Krsta Srbije, medicinski tim, fotograf i treneri u posebnom delu za hranjenje plivača koji plivaju 5, 7.5 i 10 km.

**U takmičarskoj zoni** mogu boraviti službena lica sa akreditacijom, redari, predstavnici medija, spiker, fizioterapeut-maser, dr.

**U zoni starta** mogu se nalaziti isključivo plivači koji su dužni da prate instrukcije Vrhovnog sudije.

**Kazne i Dsq** - Prilikom nastupa zabranjeno je (automatska diskvalifikacija) kraćenje staze, svaki namerni fizički kontakt (udaranje, potezanje), dodir sa kajacima i čamcima.

Trku sude sudije Plivačkog Saveza Srbije i savetujemo plivačima da tokom trke neguju sportski duh i poštuju sportska pravila usvojena od strane organizatora. Svi plivači se tretiraju jednako, a bezbednost i integritet smatraju se najvažnijima. Bilo slučajno ili namerno, doping je protiv pravila sporta. 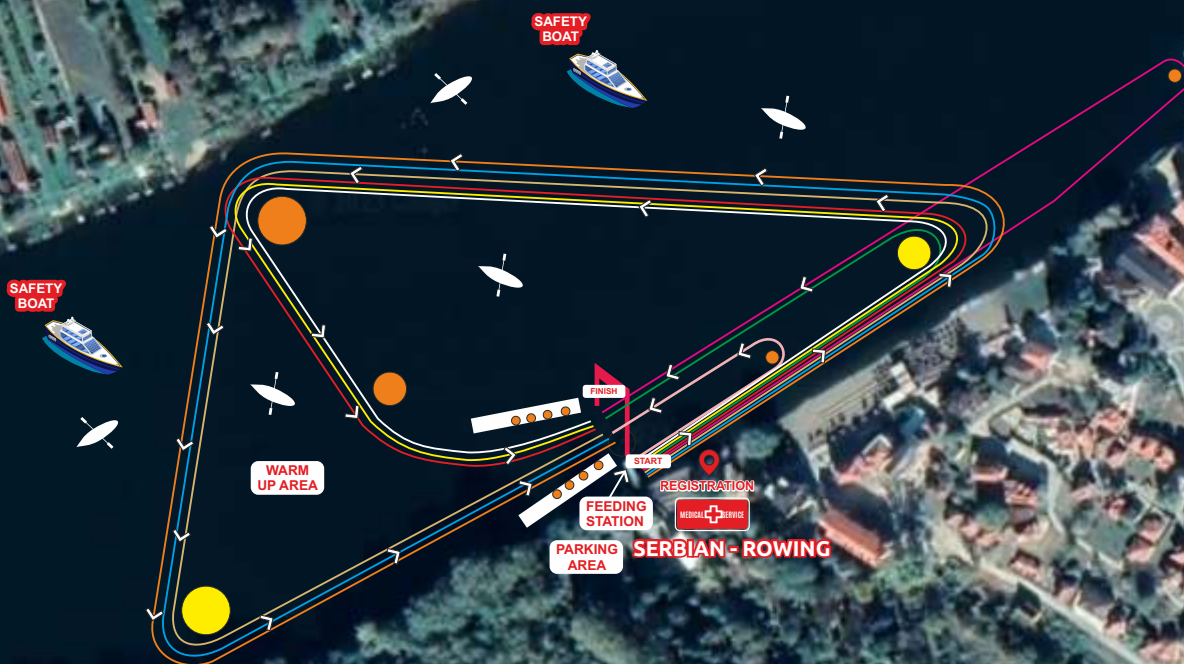

# SILVER LAKE OPEN WATER



**The only categorized open water meeting in the Republic of Serbia in 2023**

**Public parking** - is available near the venue. We ask competitors to arrive early to give themselves enough time to prepare and avoid possible crowds. Participants are allowed to pass through the gate of the "Aniva" camp in order to get their vehicles to the improvised parking area located right next to the venue. Competitors who come accompanied by their families can use camp services, which include staying and spending the night in their tents according to the price list of the camp administration. ## Competition systems

- Open Water Super League - Championship 2023
- Central Serbia Swimming Association Championship for 2023 (3 and 5 km)

## Races/Age Groups

The ranking is separated between male and female competitors.

**White Wave** – 1,500 m (12-13; 14-15; 16-18; 19-29; 30-39; 40-49; 50-59; 60+; absolute)

**Yellow Wave** – 3,000 m (14-15; 16-18; 19-29; 30-39; 40-49; 50-59; 60+; absolute)

**Blue Wave** – 5,000 m (juniors: 14-18; seniors: 19-24; masters 25+; absolute)

**Orange Wave** – 7,500 m (juniors: 14-18; seniors: 19-24; masters 25+; absolute)

**Red Wave** - 6,000 m (relay race mixed 2+2 absolute)

**Marathon (Grand Waves)** – 10.000 m (16-24; masters 25+; absolute)

Swimmers 11 yrs. they cannot swim races longer than 1,000 m.

Swimmers 12 and 13 years old. they cannot swim races longer than 2,500 m.

Swimmers over the age of 14 and 15 can swim the Marathon (10km) only with the approval of the organizer (in the case of national team members).

The 5 km race is time limited to a maximum of 120 minutes.

The 7.5 km and 10 km race is limited to a maximum of 125 minutes for men and 135 minutes for women (the condition for the race to be held is a minimum of 5 registered participants).

For licensed competitors of SSPOV results will be published in the PSS database and international databases and officially recognized.

**Para-swimmers** who have SSPOV competition IDs are welcome to participate without restrictions in all races except the marathon and are exempt from paying the registration fee.

## Races for pioneers / cadets

Placement is separated between boys and girls.

200 m - (7-8 years old)

400 m - (9-10 years old)

800 m - (11-12; 13-14 years old)

Each competitor performs at his own risk, which he confirms by his own signature on the disclaimer. Minors perform with the consent of their parents or guardians.



## Swimming lane

The finish is at the same place as the start. Swimming takes place on a circular course in a counter-clockwise direction. It is marked with buoys and at each turn there is a judge who registers the swimmers' correct passes. Competitors are obliged to go around the buoys on the right side, i.e. pass them with their left shoulder. The average water depth on the swimming course is 2-6 m. The first buoy that swimmers go around is orange (90x160cm), the next one on the turn is yellow (150x160cm), the next one is orange near the finish line (80x120cm) and after that it is yellow (90x160cm), a total of 4.

**The control** of following the swimmers takes place via the buoys on the turns, where there will be judges who will control the numbers on the caps and stickers on the swimmers' bodies. Swimmers will be timed on each swim lap when passing through the finish gate.

## Expected average values of water and air temperature on race day

T=22-25°C; T-min=22°C; T-max=37°C

Competitors receive a chip bracelet to use, which they must return to the organizer after reaching the finish line. The loss of the chip is charged 50 Eur in dinar equivalent. During swimming, it is mandatory to wear a branded cap provided by the organizer for easier identification. In case the swimmers want to use their cap, they are obliged to wear it under the official cap and to inform the registration member about it.

The competition is divided into three parts.

**The first part**, where the contestants are checked to see if they are prepared to enter the water each swimmer should be properly marked with his number (leg, arm, shoulder. shoulder blade, cap) each swimmer wears his own chip bracelet on his arm swimmers cannot wear any jewelry, watches, piercings, etc. swimmers of the announced distance must be present at the call-out point before entering the starting pontoon the Race Director will inform the Safety Officer that the First Start is ready the referee gives the Second Start with the sound of the siren. It is carried out from a pontoon

**The second part**, involves controlling the competition and monitoring the number of swimmers in the water through the following mechanisms:  
monitoring of swimmers by judges on buoy turns  
tracking of swimmers by split times provided by "Race Results" (swimmers are obliged to touch the target board with one hand while swimming through the finish gate so that the sensors detect the result from the chip bracelet)  
the safety officer must be notified of any incident in the water

**The third part**, is control at the finish line, where swimmers will be recorded their official time via "Race Results".

**Type of timing** - Electronic and manual (live results)

## The program

**11:00-13:30** - Registration

**12:40** - Technical meeting where swimmers, delegates and all teams are introduced to the most important aspects of the competition in terms of safety. The referee gives instructions to the swimmers on how to behave in the water if the weather conditions deteriorate during swimming, etc. (water pollution with dangerous substances, unannounced entry of vessels into the swimming zone, etc.)

**12:55** – Opening of the competition

**13:05 – 13:35** - Swimming warm up

**13:55** – Start of the race 200 m

**14:10** – Start of the race 400 m, 800 m

**14:50** - Start/5 km, 7.5 km 10 km, relay

**15:00** - Start/ 1,5 km, 3 km

**17:30** – Final ceremony/announcement of winners

## Prizes

The three first-placed male/female competitors at 1.5 km, 3 km, 5 km, 7.5 km and 10 km are awarded with medals by category, in the absolute competition with plaques, gifts from sponsors, in the marathon and cash prizes (1st – 150 euro, 2nd – 100 euro, 3rd – 50 euro)

The three first place pioneers and cadets in 200m, 400m and 800m are awarded with medals.

Breaking the time record on the 5 km course is rewarded with a cash prize.

The winning team in the Relay is awarded with medals.

The winners of the Championships of the Swimming Association of Central Serbia are awarded medals in age categories and cups in absolute competition.

**The Swisslion start package** includes an electronic diploma, a swimming cap with the race logo, a bag, Fruvita juice, a bottle of water, a meal, a unique participation medal, a body sticker. Contestants who complete their applications by August 19, 2023. the organizer guarantees a full participation package.

## Provided

- Regular reporting on race day weather conditions
- Precisely measured track (laser gps range finder) Navigational Aid (point to point)
- Emergency evacuation plan from water (rescuers-divers), from land (medical team and Emergency Medical Aid vehicle). In case of evacuation, the Water Rescue team will take all necessary measures without endangering the other swimmers on the swimming course. Swimmers will receive instructions on how to behave in the water due to the sudden deterioration of the weather in order to safely leave the water with the assistance of the Water Rescue team. In the event that a swimmer is noticed missing on the swimming course, the search will begin at the first control point where the information about the swimmer is missing.

- Chief Timekeeper (National Swimming Judge)

**The final results** will be displayed on the notice board at 17:15 p.m., complaints can be submitted within the next 10 minutes with referee (the supreme judge). The announcer will inform the contestants about the beginning of the submission deadline, i.e. the expiration of the deadline, through the loudspeaker.

**The safety** of swimmers is taken care of by a professional rescue team (lifeguard-divers) with a developed Action Plan for Emergency Evacuation and First Aid. Kayaks and boats patrol the swimming course during the race, while a vehicle with the Emergency Medical Service is on duty on the shore. Communication between the teams takes place through the water-water, water-land and land-land radio communication system.

Judges, lifeguards, timekeepers, the First Aid team of the Red Cross of Serbia, a medical team, a photographer and coaches can stay on the starting pontoon in a special area for refreshments for swimmers who swim 5, 7.5 and 10 km.

Officials with accreditation may stay in **the competition zone**: ushers, media representatives, announcer, physiotherapist-masseur, etc.

**The starting zone** - only swimmers, who are obliged to follow the instructions of the referee (Supreme Judge).

**Penalties and Dsq** During the performance, it is forbidden (automatic disqualification) to shorten the course, any intentional physical contact (hitting, pulling) with kayaks and boats. The race is judged by the judges of the Swimming Federation of Serbia and we advise swimmers to maintain sportsmanship during the race and respect the sports rules adopted by the organizers. All swimmers are treated equally, and safety and integrity are considered paramount.

Whether accidental or intentional, doping is against the rules of the sport. Click on the link below to make sure you are working in accordance with the rules of the Anti-Doping Agency of the Republic of Serbia.
